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





Patterns are important in language. The order of words is important to grammar and meaning. For example, 'John killed the bear' doesn't mean the same as 'The bear killed John'. Both sentences have the same words, but they are in a different order. The experiment shows that babies start to learn grammar rules from the beginning of their life. Language is important for child development. Babies can hear language in various ways: listening to television, audio books or the Internet and interacting with people. A scientist, Patricia Kuhl, compared two groups of nine-month-old American babies. Both groups heard Mandarin Chinese sounds. The first group watched videos. In the second group, people spoke the same sounds to the babies. Then they tested the babies. The second group recognized the different sounds. The first group learned nothing.
